

# WOW! Science Camp Supply List 2022

Please send these supplies in your child's backpack on Monday of your child's camp session. Thank you for helping us to make Science Camp a wonderful learning experience for your child! If you have any questions, e-mail us at [wowsciencecamp@sbcglobal.net](mailto:wowsciencecamp@sbcglobal.net).

**\*\*Please send your child in socks and tennis shoes. Our nature walks will be near wooded or grassy areas. Apply sunscreen before camp. Also, it is a good idea to send a plastic grocery bag every day for the materials your child will be bringing home in their backpack.**

## Supply List for the 5 classes in Group B

1. 16.9 oz. empty plastic drinking bottle, any brand; Please peel label off.
2. 1 hard-boiled brown egg with shell on, in a Ziploc baggie; Brown eggs are preferable but not mandatory. Please let us know if your child has an egg allergy. These eggs will NOT be eaten but used in an experiment.
3. 1 adult men's long sock (dress or athletic), any color; Old, clean ones are great to use.
4. 1-5 dirty pennies, Campers will clean these using a reaction.
5. A drink every day (juice or water bottle); Please label with child's name.
6. Please send a small to medium bag of goldfish, Teddy Grahams, Ritz crackers, Graham crackers (especially needed this summer), popcorn, or other snack (nothing with peanut butter) with your child to share with the class for snack time this week. *\*NOTE: We cannot accept snacks that have been opened. Please send unopened bags. Thank you!*
7. Optional: Your child may bring small animals like earthworms, safe insects, doodlebugs (also called Roly-poly), snails, pet snakes, lizards, frogs, toads, small turtles, etc., for show and tell. Label all containers with child's name. Please ask their teacher first at camp or e-mail Science Camp for permission if you are in doubt about a certain type of animal.
